## SAFETY NOTE #6: WHAT HAPPENED??

If you are involved in, or witness, an incident or near miss related to safety, REPORT IT!!

- 2<sup>nd</sup> You and / or your supervisor need to file an incident report with the University of Arizona Risk Management at <a href="https://risk.arizona.edu/insurance/incident-reporting">https://risk.arizona.edu/insurance/incident-reporting</a>, or in UAccess Employee, under Employee for yourself, or Manager for Supervisors
- 3<sup>rd</sup> You and / or your supervisor and / or witness need to file an incident / near miss report
  with the Executive Safety Committee (copy attached), or you may find either a Adobe or
  Word version on the Steward Observatory Safety page (under SO Resources /
  Safety <a href="https://www.as.arizona.edu/steward-observatory-safety-manual#Near-Miss">https://www.as.arizona.edu/steward-observatory-safety-manual#Near-Miss</a>)

## YOUR INCIDENT REPORT TO THE UA IS IMPORTANT.

It is required within 24 hours and provides the basis for treatment or potentially current or future claims

## YOUR INCIDENT AND NEAR MISS REPORTING TO THE SAFETY COMMITTEE IS IMPORTANT.

It provides valuable information that allows us to:

- Recommend changes to policies and procedures
- Provide presentations that provide the most relevant information to all of us
- Develop / recommend safety courses that provide a more in-depth understanding of risk and risk management

Be conscious of safety in your work, with your team, and in your surroundings, including at home too!!
